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RECEIVER'S SEVENTH REPORT FOR THE MONTHS OF JUNE AND JULY 2015  
AND MOTION TO APPROVE GRAVE SPACE DISPUTE PROCEDURE

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Pursuant to the Order entered December 2, 2014, Julie Mix McPeak, Commissioner of the Department of Commerce & Insurance, Receiver for Hawkins County Memorial Gardens, (hereafter referred to as HCMG) through her appointed Special Deputy Receiver, Receivership Management Inc., causes to be filed this monthly report and states to the Court as follows:

1. On February 3, 2015, Defendant Vickie Ringley was arrested on two counts of theft over \$60,000, two counts of money laundering, one count of forgery and seven counts of failure to follow cemetery regulations. Court records list 370 victims linked to the two theft charges. Defendant Ringley remains incarcerated on a \$200,000.00 bond. Hawkins County Criminal Court Judge John Dugger has set a trial date of October 13, 2015. The Receiver and the Special Deputy Receiver continue to cooperate with the District Attorney for the Third Judicial District.

2. The Special Deputy Receiver has received 358 grave space ownership claims and it is currently working through those. Three hundred three (303) claims have been determined to present no issues of ownership. Fifty five claims however do present issues of ownership. During

the course of working through the grave space ownership claims, 17 additional lots were discovered to have multiple registered owners. Currently, after taking into consideration the 12 lots resolved earlier, this leaves 133 lots with multiple registered owners.

3. Long's Cemetery Service mowed the cemetery in preparation for the 4<sup>TH</sup> July Holiday. Long's next scheduled mowing is before the Labor Day Holiday. Two teens seeking credit for the Tennessee Promise Program completed 8 hours of community service volunteer work at the cemetery in July.

4. During the month of July, the Special Deputy Receiver was notified that a complaint to the media had been made regarding broken, damaged, or missing grave vases. No complaint of this nature had been received directly by either the Receiver or the Special Deputy Receiver. In addition, at the time the Special Deputy took control of the premises at the start of the receivership, an inspection and photographs were taken. Since that time it does not appear that additional damages have occurred and the cemetery is inspected by an agent of the Special Deputy Receiver after each mowing; however the cemetery is an open cemetery and other families mow their areas independently of Long's Cemetery Service. The Receiver responded to the media reports and the Special Deputy Receiver's office responded in person with the complainant who could not provide evidence of damage since the receivership but "just knew it had happened." The Special Deputy Receiver recently received a complaint that a bronze date marker was removed from a marker. The complainant requested the cemetery to replace it; the Special Deputy Receiver advised the complainant to contact a local funeral home and the complainant could make a claim against the receivership estate for a refund, if funds were available to make such payments.

5. Since taking possession, twenty-eight (28) burials have occurred as of July 31, 2015 and the procedure granting approval continues to work well. An interment log is being maintained by the Special Deputy Receiver. Mr. Moore maintains open lines of communication with all funeral homes in the area.

6. A claim on the theft coverage has been filed with Auto Owners Insurance. They are continuing to investigate this claim and have issued a reservation of rights letter. Since that

time, we have been investigating issues related to this claim. Auto-Owners has issued a letter that they do not believe coverage for the alleged theft of funds is covered by the policy. Following a review of the facts of the claim and consultation of legal counsel, the Special Deputy Receiver has determined that a claim against this policy, because the terms of the policy did not include Ms. Ringley herself, would be unlikely to succeed and, as such, is not expected to be further pursued in the future.

7. On June 25, 2015, I received correspondence from Ms. Ringley. I responded to that correspondence on July 7, 2015. See attached as **Collective Exhibit 1**.

8. On August 12, 2015, during the drafting of this report, I received additional correspondence from Ms. Ringley. I responded to that correspondence on August 17, 2015. See attached as **Collective Exhibit 2**.

#### **PROPOSED PROCEDURE TO RESOLVE DISPUTED GRAVE SPACES**

9. To those parties who submitted grave space claims for which there are no disputes, the Special Deputy Receiver proposes to issue the letter attached as **Exhibit 3**.

10. To those parties who submitted grave space claims for which there are disputes, the Special Deputy Receiver proposes to determine who among the claimants purchased first. If the space is currently being used by a claimant or occupant who purchased after the earlier claimant, the Special Deputy will seek agreement from the dispossessed claimant to waive its claim and be reassigned a known unsold vacant grave space. Should the dispossessed claimant not agree, the other claimant or occupant's family will be notified that his or her right to that space may be challenged and the dispossessed claimant may exercise his/her rights (at his sole expense) which may include the dispossessed claimant seeking an order of exhumation. Should an order of exhumation occur, the Special Deputy Receiver recommends that it make available a known unsold vacant grave space to the family of the exhumed.

11. The Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver propose that they be authorized by this Court to reassign spaces and to issue deeds recognizing the reassignments. In addition, the


Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver propose that they be authorized to issue duplicate/replacement deeds as requested claimants.

12. The procedure outlined here addresses the need for quick resolutions of disputes while at the same time acknowledges the fact the receivership estate has no funds on which to operate. The full cost of the receivership is being borne by the Cemetery Consumer Protection Fund. This cemetery, as well as another cemetery receivership that is in a similar circumstance, is placing a great deal of strain on the Fund. To that end, this procedure leaves the cost of a dispossessed claimant upon the claimant. Certainly, and at some point, if funds become available to address these types of claims, and other claims as well, for expenses, a proof of claim process will be proposed to the Court. At this time, such a proposal is premature.

**PREMISES CONSIDERED**, the Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver move this Court to:

1. Approve the procedure to resolve disputed grave spaces.
2. Set a status conference in this matter.



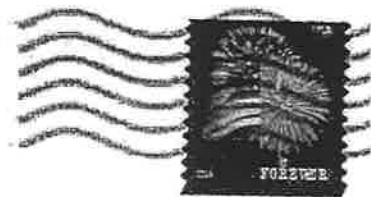

Dear Ms. Ringley:

I am responding to your request for information. I received your letter of June 8, 2015 on June 25, 2015. In your letter you stated the following:

“I am requesting names and burials-you have stated that there are 128 double sold lots in that report from Mr. Moore and I need a list of the names-also a list of names on burials.”

I am not sure what you mean by a list of names of burials. Enclosed with this letter is a listing of the lots that may have been double sold along with the names of the registered owners and the name of the person buried in the spot (if someone is buried with a marker or someone is listed as being buried there according to cemetery records). We are still sorting out ownership claims on burial plots.


In your letter, you make reference to Claude and Irene Baxter. I reviewed their record. According to cemetery files, their daughter Melissa is buried in Lot 108, Section A, Grave Space 3. Cemetery files list Irene Baxter owner of Garden of Everlasting Life, Lot 108, Grave Spaces 3 and 4. No owner is listed for Spaces 1 and 2.

Cemetery records also indicate that on May 16, 1995 a letter was issued by Sharon Williams to Mr. and Mrs. Baxter stating, among other things, they had purchased 3 grave spaces (Garden of Everlasting Life Lot 108, Section A, Spaces 1, 2, 3 and child protection on Lot 4) and demanding payment of \$511.76. This letter indicated these amounts as outstanding payments; however this was not the total balance due on the account. The letter also states that if payment was not received the account would be cancelled out and turned over to a collection agency. There is nothing in the file confirming that the account was turned over to a collection agency nor is there a letter to Mr. and Mrs. Baxter stating that the account was now closed out and they no longer own the grave spaces in the cemetery.

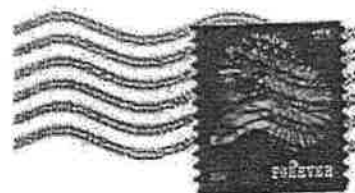

Dear Ms. Ringley:

I am responding to your request for information. I received your letter of June 8, 2015 on June 25, 2015 and I responded on July 7, 2015. I have received two additional letters from you on August 12, 2015. I am responding to those additional letters.

1. You have requested a complete list of all interments names, space numbers and date of interment since "you all had Long's Grave Digging and Funeral Homes."

RESPONSE: To be clear-Hawkins County Memorial Gardens does not have funds to hire grave digging. You have disclosed no bank account with any operational funds or a trust account holding pre-need services funds. All grave digging that has been done since the start of the receivership has been contracted by the funeral home in charge of the particular service and paid for by the family to the funeral home as part of the funeral service. If there is recovery of funds as a part of the receivership, Hawkins County Memorial Gardens will owe a refund to those families.

Enclosed is a listing of interments that have occurred since the receivership was established on December 2, 2014. The listing includes the name of the deceased, address of the deceased or next of kin, the garden, lot, section, and space of the burial, the funeral home in charge, the contact at the funeral home, the date the burial was approved, and the date of the interment. Also the next of kin if available is listed as well.

The receivership order was issued on December 2, 2014. As such, the State of Tennessee did not control or operate the cemetery until that date. You speak of Gloria Bryant who was buried on February 22, 2014 in an incorrect space. At that time the cemetery was not under the operation and control of the Tennessee Commissioner of Commerce and Insurance as receiver. I will nevertheless investigate your allegation of incorrect burial.

2. You state the following in your letter: "Also it was on news that vases were damaged and you all blamed me for that, untrue if you look back there were no paper of

complaints on vases and no one has been supervising any graves being dug or mowing so I will not be held responsible for that since I was not allowed in cemetery since February 2014.”

RESPONSE: Our statement to the press was that we had not received any complaints about broken vases, which is true. We stated that when we took over in December, 2014 there were a number of damaged and missing vases then. Again, that is true. Nowhere in our statement to the press were you mentioned or specifically blamed. I note that the news reporter indicated you were in jail but we made no statement of blame against you. I and my assistant on the day we took over the cemetery in December, 2014 noted a number of damaged vases in the cemetery. We are unaware of additional damage. My assistant met and spoke with Pat Lipe, who made the complaints. Ms. Lipe was not able to provide any proof that new damage had occurred since December 2014.

As noted in our court report, a request for bids to mow the cemetery was published in the Rogersville newspaper. Only two (2) companies responded: T&C Lawn Services for \$1,000 for mowing, trimming, and blowing per mow and Long's Cemetery Services at \$1,400.00 (\$600.00 for mowing/\$400 for trimming or blowing.) When it was disclosed we would only be able to afford to mow 5 times this season, T&C Lawn Services withdrew its bid as they only wanted the job if they would be permitted to mow every two weeks. Under the law regulating the Improvement Care Trust, the Trust can only pay earnings (not the percentage you as the cemetery owner were allowed to withdraw). Those earnings, after deduction for the Trust company fees and services, were approximately just under \$700.00. As a result, the cost of mowing has been billed as a cost of the receivership which was approved at \$600.00 per mow (no trimming or blowing was approved) with only 5 mows approved. The cemetery has been mowed for Mother's Day, Memorial Day, and the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday. It will be mowed for Labor Day and one additional mow at the end of the season. I am attempting to gain approval for trimming and blowing for when the cemetery is mowed in anticipation for Labor Day.

All mowing is inspected by my assistant, Jacqui Lawson, at the time the mowing is concluded. No grave may be dug without prior approval from my office. The funeral home that has charge is responsible for the proper digging of graves. Digging and burial inspections are conducted as well by my assistant.

3. You have made a second request for a listing of potentially double sold lots. In your second letter you ask, “Also, where is the money going for opening/closings and lots etc. Is it going to you or Funeral Home?”

RESPONSE: I provided a listing of graves spaces that we believe may be double sold. The list includes the garden, lot number, and name of owner. We are still working through claims of 55 people whose spaces may be double sold. They are included in this list.

The cemetery is not conducting any sales of lots. Further, we do not contract for openings/closings because there is no money to do so. All opening/closings are

contracted by the family through the funeral home in charge. People who paid you for preneed openings and closings are having to pay a second time to the funeral home who then contracts with a grave digger to dig the grave.


4. Your second letter states: "I am requesting that I also did not fully understand that I was signing my cemetery over in November, 2014. I am very worried about the situation. I know people have been writing me, saying it is not being taken care of. I think some or a lot of people would agree that I could go back and make some of the things right—I had a good reputation before my husband done a lot of this—if you talk to some of the Funeral Directors, they would tell you about his addiction, especially James Sells and Chris Christian of Christian Sells, I had money he stole from me on many occasions."

RESPONSE: I understand you are not represented by counsel in the receivership matter. The receivership matter is different from the administrative proceeding regarding your cemetery registration. They are two separate cases. It has been alleged in the receivership case that you failed to maintain a pre-need services and merchandise trust account and you have failed to account for those pre-need funds paid to you for those services and merchandise. Based on your completed sales records alone, you, as the operator of Hawkins County Memorial Gardens, should have trusted \$612,579.73. This means that you as the operator have the obligation to deliver at least \$612,579.72 worth of merchandise and services and you have stated you have no funds from which to operate the cemetery. The only asset of the operation is the cemetery property itself. The operation of a cemetery is something a kin to a public trust. The State of Tennessee establishes statutes and regulations which allow a person to operate a cemetery. When those statutes and rules are broken, that person loses that right, which may include the property which forms the operation. You have a right to be heard on any proposal or plan that is submitted for the future operation and maintenance of the cemetery. At this stage of the receivership, we have not finalized a proposal forward and have not submitted a plan for the future operation and maintenance of the cemetery; we have spoken of potentially selling the cemetery in order to raise the funds for the pre-need services and merchandise trust. This has in no way been finalized and will not be until we have resolved all grave space disputes.

I will share your correspondence with the receivership Court.

I hope the enclosed information is responsive to your request.
