FINAL ACCOUNTING AND MOTION FOR DISCHARGE

Pursuant to the Order of the Court dated September 29, 2008 (D.E. 1440) the Independent Fiduciary submits this Final Accounting and Motion for Discharge for the Service and Business Workers of America Local 125 Benefit Fund Estate. As set forth in the previous Order, the Independent Fiduciary advises the court that payment from the Brown bankruptcy in the amount of \$35,219.93 was received and included with the final distribution. Therefore, The Independent Fiduciary hereby advises the Court that all tasks as set forth in the Order have been completed and this case now ready to be closed.

The Independent Fiduciary advises the Court as follows:


1. Distributions have been made to 1494 claimants, totaling \$2,788,679.96. This distribution of all available funds as set forth in

the previous Order resulted in a pro-rata distribution to all approved claimants of approximately 24% of their total approved claims.

2. Any amounts from these distributions to claimants whose checks were returned as undeliverable were paid to the various State Unclaimed Property funds as set forth in the April 12, 2010 Notice of Payments to State Unclaimed Property Funds (D.E.1452).
3. A summary accounting of the total amounts distributed to claimants, paid to Unclaimed Funds, and the amounts reserved for records retention and destruction is attached as Exhibit 1.

Therefore, the Independent Fiduciary having completed all tasks, taken all reasonable efforts to pay all claimants, and distributed all funds, requests a Order of Final Discharge and Closing of the Estate from the court, including the extinguishment of any bonding requirement presently upon the Independent Fiduciary.


