**PROPOSED ORDER**

This matter is before the Court as a result of a Motion filed by the Receiver through her appointed Special Deputy Receiver on August 20, 2015 and set for hearing on September 4, 2015. Said Motion sought approval of the Letter to Grave Space Claimants whose claims are not disputed (Exhibit 3 to the Seventh Report and Motion of the Special Deputy Receiver), approval of a procedure to resolve disputed grave space claims, and a status hearing on the receivership. Appearing for the Special Deputy Receiver was Robert E. Moore, Jr. No objection to the Special Deputy Receiver's Motion was filed.

The Court having questioned Mr. Moore regarding the proposed procedure and having drawn an understanding from both Mr. Moore and the record in this matter, and in the absence of any filed objection, the Court GRANTS the Motion of the Special Deputy Receiver and DIRECTS the Receiver and Special Deputy Receiver as follows:

1. The Special Deputy Receiver shall immediately issue the approved letter to Grave Space Claimants whose claims are not disputed.

2. The Special Deputy Receiver shall initiate the process and procedure to resolve disputed grave spaces as outlined in the Seventh Report and Motion of the Special Deputy Receiver, with the following additional provisions: If a dispute over a grave space cannot be resolved, a notice to the Court of those claimants whose dispute cannot be resolved shall be filed by the Special Deputy Receiver. The Court will provide notice to those claimants advising them of the process by which their dispute may be heard by the Court. Requests for exhumations (if any) during the pendency of the receivership proceeding shall be made to this Court exclusively, with notice to the Special Deputy Receiver.

The Court further ORDERS that a status hearing on the receivership proceeding ~~is hereby~~ <sup>shall be</sup> set for September 25, 2015 at 10:30 AM central time. ~~The Court directs the Special Deputy Receiver to investigate possible methods by which Defendant Vickie Ringley~~ <sup>to</sup> ~~may~~ participant in

~~said hearing.~~ <sup>listen, and if she chooses, to address the Court. To implement</sup> ~~The hearing, on or before September 23, 2015, the Special Deputy Receiver shall file a list of matters he intends to report to~~ <sup>the Court at the status hearing. The reason for the list is to provide notice to the Defendant. After the list has been filed, the Docket Clerk shall contact the Special Deputy Receiver and the Hawkins County Sheriff's Office to set a date and time for the hearing to be conducted by telephone.</sup>


